When I hear long-standing parishioners who don't know one another after 20/30 years because he/she goes to a different Mass, I wonder how we are to create a sense of community, pool our resources in the liturgy and the Mission of the Church here in Dover. Pope Francis has called for a 'New Evangelisation' – do we understand what he is talking about, and do we say 'that's not for me'?
